David (Ze'ev) Jablinowitz, born in Brooklyn, moved to Israel right out of college (1981), is currently the Op Ed Editor of The Jerusalem Post, author of Israel's "Bus Stories" on Facebook and compiling stories for a book-in-progress. From 1981 to 2018 he broadcasted on Israeli radio, reporting on political and diplomatic affairs.

David has interviewed seven Israeli Prime Ministers and in 2016 conducted a phone conversation with then President Barack Obama, after which the President dropped a plan to present a UN Security Council resolution on the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. The US-sponsored resolution would have stipulated the parameters for a resolution to the conflict and a timeframe for reaching an agreement. The conversation with the President is referenced in Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's recently-published memoirs.
